the Chair of History and Theory of International Relations of Dostoevsky Omsk State University (Omsk, Russia) organizes the international scientific and practical conference **"The European Union at the Present Time: Problems and Prospects of Development"** in the framework of the Erasmus+ Jean Monnet Project.

As a result of the conference, participants' reports will be published in the scientific journal "Herald of Omsk University. Series "Historical Studies" included in the Higher Attestation Commission List after the corresponding peer review.

Under the conditions of the grant project, the organizers will cover travel, accommodation and meals for a limited number of conference participants.

## **REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PREPARATION OF REPORT**

Text should be typed in MS Word in .doc or .docx format, font Times New Roman, Size -14 (for foot-notes/notes -12), the interval 1.5, fields: left 3 cm, right 1.5 cm, top and bottom -2 cm. The number of characters should be max 20 000.

Orientation - portrait, no page numbering, no hyphenation.

First line indent 1.25 is set automatically. In case of a reference to a monograph or memoir, the surname and initials of the author in a foot-note are in italics. Endnotes, continuous page numbering.

Requirements for the publication of a scientific article in the journal "Herald of Omsk University. Series "Historical Studies" will be sent to the participants separately.
